- <u>Carnival Kay Erickson -</u> The Country Fair carnival was a success despite the rain and having to move it indoors.
 - When everything is paid in full, the carnival should net approximately \$4,500.
- <u>Chat n Chew Debbie Landes</u> There will be a Chat n Chew pizza party on Thursday, May 25th. Invitations will go out to the kids a week or two prior to that. I sent one group leader from each group an attendance sheet to complete and return to me so I can send the invitations to the kids who completed all four books. Group leaders are also invited and will need to RSVP on the attendance sheet. I will ask the kids for feedback on the books at the Pizza party and include the feedback in the Chat n Chew committee notebook to use when the book selection is made for next year's books. Thanks to anyone who was a leader this year!
